CIS E-Learning Guide for Students*

In preparation for the launch of e-learning on Sunday, Mar 22, please adhere to the following expectations during our online learning phase:

- ✓ Ensure access to a device to work from home.
- ✓ Ensure access to the internet during regular school hours (8 a.m. 3 p.m., Sunday-Thursday).
- ✓ Teachers will be available online from 8 a.m. 3 p.m. Sunday-Thursday.
 - Teachers will respond to student/parent questions between 8 a.m. and 3 p.m. (within a maximum of 24 hours), on weekdays.
- ✓ **Attendance**. Teachers will monitor attendance through engagement with e-learning tasks and will contact students and parents daily with concerns. Administration will be notified if students are "absent" after 48 hours, in order to contact home.
 - Logging in alone does not count as being present/engaged. You need to be going through the materials and completing assigned tasks. Evidence of engagement may include answers to daily questions, forum discussion contributions, comments, Forms, electronically signing-in, etc.
 - Each daily class will have a scheduled assignment or process to ensure that you are engaged in your classes daily. It is your responsibility to complete the attendance requirement for each assigned course in your timetable.
- ✓ Access your class' group on Class Dojo/Edmodo/Microsoft Teams to access plans and resources.
 - A weekly overview will be shared by 8 a.m. each Sunday for each class. Daily resources and expectations will be shared on an ongoing basis.
- ✓ Follow your timetable in accessing work and completing the work as assigned.
- ✓ If a teacher schedules a live videoconference during assigned class time, students are expected to join online. Students are to be seated at a table during the conference and not on beds or in bedrooms. Students should be dressed appropriately for the conference (no pajamas).
- ✓ Remember that all interactions on an e-learning platform should be exemplary and adhere to the school's Discipline Policy and Student Handbook.
- ✓ Assessment. You will be assessed on an ongoing basis in both core and specialist classes/options.
 - Teachers will assess your work, and they will continue to enter grades in PowerSchool.
 - Your parents may be asked to supervise you as you complete and submit an assessment to ensure that expectations are followed. They will be contacted in advance of this.
- ✓ Attitude is everything. Numerous studies have already proven the power of positive thinking and just how effective our minds can be when it comes to altering our perception on things. As an e-Learner, the first and most important thing you can do is to shift your attitude towards study from thinking of it as a chore and turning it into something you enjoy.
