Weekly Parent Memo

CIS Parent PowerSchool Portal

All parents are issued with a login to the PowerSchool portal.

PowerSchool notifications

Parents are able to turn on their notifications which will alert them to any entries relating to their child's records.

Class DOJO

All parents with students in KG1 through Grade 3 will have access to Class DOJO. This platform allows interaction between the class teacher and families.

Microsoft TEAMS and teamup

All students in Grades 4 through 12 will have access to Microsoft Teams either for their homeroom or for each course. Parents are able to access these groups using their students log in credentials. Teamup links for Grades 7 through 12 are available through the website (Student Life tab).
