Calculators and Technology

- Students in grades 7 to 9 are required to have a scientific calculator. Course teachers recommend Texas Instrument (TI) 84+ or CE and can provide detailed support on its application.
- At the secondary level students utilize TEAMS and other elements of the Microsoft 365 suite on a daily basis. Students are asked to bring a personally labeled laptop or Chromebook to school on a daily basis to ensure they are able to fully participate in course work. The school has a limited number of devices and cannot guarantee student access daily.
